

install Windows 11 without a Microsoft account

Step-by-step Guide

- 1. Prepare your installation media:** Use the [Media Creation Tool](#) to create a bootable Windows 11 USB drive.
- 2. Start the installation:** Boot your computer from the USB drive and begin the Windows 11 setup process.
- 3. Disconnect from the internet:** At the "Let's connect you to a network" screen during the out-of-box-experience (OOBE), ensure you are not connected to the internet.
- 4. Open Command Prompt:** Press **Shift + F10** to open the Command Prompt window.
- 5. Enter the bypass command:** Type Oobe\BypassNro and press Enter.
If found an error Type **ipconfig /release**
- 6. Restart the PC:** The computer will restart and take you back to the OOBE setup screen.
- 7. Create a local account:** You should now see the option to create a local account instead of being forced to sign in with a Microsoft account.
- 8. Complete the setup:** Follow the remaining prompts to complete the Windows 11 installation using your new local account.

Note:

For newer versions of Windows 11.....

Press **Shift + F10**

Type start ms-cxh:localonly

If this account is for a child or teenager, consider selecting **Back** and creating a Microsoft account. When younger family members log in with a Microsoft account, they'll have privacy protections focused on their age.
